3. Minutes – Reviewed and approved by all
4. Old Business
 - a. Confirmation update – began with a parent meeting and have had two classes to date for both the Freshman and Sophomores
 - i. Day of Recollection, February 3 at 6pm with Fr. Jarrod Lies
Event went well and was well attended - scheduled during the day during a Teacher-in-Service and also in the evening for the Parish
 - b. Consecration to St. Joseph: scheduled to end March 19 in Fayette with a dinner at 6:30
 - c. Consecration to the Blessed Mother: scheduled to end March 25th at SSPP with a dinner at 6:30 (the Feast of the Annunciation)
