Meeting minutes – November 3, 2015

The meeting was opened by President Cynda West as the group came together in prayer.

Secretary's Report

Elizabeth Atkinson reviewed the minutes of the last meeting. Jackie Leonard made a motion to approve the minutes and Elaine Green seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

Lori Rowlett gave the Treasurer's Report. She mentioned that half of the Home & School dues have been collected.

Edward Jones Vote

The information presented by Matt Kueny at the previous meeting was reviewed, and the results of the Google Docs vote was revealed. 40 families voted YES to have an initial investment of \$10,000.

President Cynda West asked everyone in attendance if they had any questions. Lori Rowlett, Treasurer, stated that she would contact Matt Kueny to make the initial investment.

Principal's Report

Principal Alan Lammers explained that the Christmas Program would be held in the school gym instead of Church this year. He stated that he needs volunteers to help with set-up and teardown of the chairs and risers. Principal Lammers stated that he was pleased with how Grandparent's Day went and thanked everyone for their help. Risa Venable asked Principal Lammers if anything had been decided about security cameras. Principal Lammers explained that a proposal has been submitted to the Diocese.

New Business

1) Wrapping Paper Update

President Cynda West explained that this year's fundraiser was a big success. There was over \$20,000 in sales with \$4,000 more profit than budgeted. Due to the success, all classes were able to have an ice cream party. It was mentioned that Tari Frederick would like someone else to take it over for next school year.

2) Book Fair

Elaine Green stated that the Book Fair ends on Wednesday. Jennifer Spears and Missy Stock have agreed to take over the Book Fair for next year.

3) SCRIP

Elaine Green explained that there is an increased inventory due to the Turkey Dinner and holiday purchases.

4) Chili Supper

Shannon Griffy stated that the date for the Carnival and Chili Supper is February 5, 2016. She stated that a Google Doc will most likely come out for volunteers to sign up.

5) Carnival Decorations

Risa Venable and Jackie Leonard are in charge of doing the decorations for the Carnival. It was mentioned that the decorations will be reused for the Auction as well. They stated that they would like to get the students involved and will be in contact with the teachers after Christmas break.

6) Carnival Games/Coordination

Cynda West and Theresa Krebs will be in charges of the coordination. They stated that they are open to any and all suggestions.

7) Parent Breakfasts

Lori Imhoff explained that they will most likely doing one breakfast in January and one in the spring. There was some discussion held regarding the Mass schedule in January due to Fr. Basil being out of town. It was mentioned that the most likely date would be the end of January on a Friday.

8) STUCO Dance

The dance is scheduled for November 13th from 7pm to 10pm in the school cafeteria. The theme is 'Dancing through the Decades' and is open for 4th through 8th grades. There is a flyer that will be in the Friday Folders.

9) Playground Renovations

There has been a lot of planning going on with regard to the playground renovations. They have identified 5 areas to make improvements. Possibilities are: a play area into the hill, pea gravel area, rope swing, rope bridge, and many other ideas. The committee hopes to make these renovations in the Spring.

10) Service Project

Jennifer Spears stated that the committee has decided on 3 service projects for the year. First, they will deliver holiday decorations to the Cooper County Memorial Hospital on December 11th. Pickup Boonville event will be sometime in March or April. They will also do a project with the Children's Hospital in the spring. All activities will be done after school.

11) 5K and Fun Run

Kelly Rohrbach explained that the 5K will most likely be in April to help avoid other area 5k's. There has been some talk about changing the venue, but no decisions have been made. Kelly Rohrbach also mentioned that orders for Pep Club shirts are due by Friday so they can be received by the first home game.

12) Garage Sale

Jill Daniel has agreed to head up a garage sale in the spring. She stated that she hopes it will coincide with the Boonville City Wide Garage Sales. Students would be able to assist with working and with pricing items. Mandy Eichelberger made a motion to add the Garage Sale as an additional fundraiser for Home & School. Lori Imhoff seconded the motion. Motion passed.

13) Auction Update

Mona Brownfield stated that this is the 30th year for the auction. The auction will be Saturday, February 27th. She reminded everyone that Ladies Day is Sunday from 3-5, but if anyone is unable to make it, they will email out the links to order online.

14) Welcome Committee

Dan Schuster, member of the School Advisory Board, stated that the School Advisory Board would like to come together with Home & School and put together a welcome committee to make new families and transfer families feel more welcome. The details have not been figured out, but Mr. Schuster asked for volunteers.

15) Fund Requests

- A.** Mrs. Rapp submitted a request for various pull down maps for her classroom for a total of \$390.00. Crystal Wilson made a motion to approve this request, and Jessica Johnson seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- B.** Mrs. Kirchner submitted a request for various pull down maps, as well, for her classroom, but does not need as many as Mrs. Rapp. The total is \$245.50. Crystal Wilson make a motion to approve this request, and Shannon Griffy seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- C.** Lila has submitted a request for window tinting in the cafeteria. The estimate is for \$985, which does not include a lift that is needed, but that is being donated. Some discussion was held regarding the estimate and Crystal Wilson mentioned the possibility of getting a second estimate through a company in Sedalia that is willing to travel. It was mentioned that if a second estimate was received that a Google Doc vote could be held if it was before the next meeting. Mandy Eichelberger made the motion to table the fund request for window tinting awaiting a second estimate, and Jackie Leonard seconded the motion. Motion passed.
